4. Trustee report - Luci

Letters were written to the government by ACA related to lack of covid health restrictions within the school resulting in greater uncertainty, increased division within our communities across the province. The letter(s) ask:

- The government to mandate all school staff be vaccinated.
- Transparency of Covid cases in classes for parents. Parents feel entitled to know in order to make the right decisions for their families.
- Provision for additional resources such as rapid testing kits, ventilation improvement at no cost to school or division.
- Mandatory rapid testing for systemic individuals regardless of vaccine status.
- Reinstatement of contact tracing.
- Etc.

Wolfcreek had elections, everyone acclaimed except Ward C.

5. Principal's report -

- A. School staffing
 - a. - Welcome Abbey - Great addition to our office team and our school staff all together.
 - b. - New custodian Julie, she works from 7 a.m. until 1:30. We also have Greg the night janitor. He comes in from 2 to 10:30. Together they do a bang up job in regards to covid cleaning.

- B. School numbers
 - a. At school 198 - up over 20 students since covid this time last year. The school lost a family of three to online schooling through Red Deer Catholic, because Wolfcreek closed the door on this option. We can't be losing kids to other schools like this. Last year's decrease in numbers resulted in Clive school losing a teacher.
- C. Covid re-entry update - Outbreak status (more than 10% mid September)
 - a. At 10% the school has to notify AHS. This includes all attendance regarding sickness.
 - b. Student/staff illness - Thanks for keeping kids home that are ill.
- D. School Assurance Planning
 - a. Schools across the province have been asked to look at Assurance Planning. It's a long term goal and planning regards to seeing growth in our building. Abbey and Ted have started the Assurance planning for Clive and shared some of it with staff at the kickoff meeting. A lot of emphasis on math. Last year we brought a math expert to help us teachers become better math instructors. Another area is kindness. We want to highlight kindness at Clive school. It's all wrapped around the safe and caring aspect. Abbey is going to be working closely with the teachers in regards to IPP goals. Student survey showed that students want more choice of options. They were ticked that band was not able to run and even elementary grades are asking for more opportunities.

 - c. Sports teams - Three volleyball teams, 16 golfers, many who've never played before. Thanks to Haunted Lakes golf course for accommodating the golfers.
